Emergency Essentials - On the Road

Vehicle - bug-out-bag (BOB)

Stored in the vehicle

Air pump & tire gauge (stored in glove box or trunk)
Overalls or discardable old clothes (stored in trunk)
Extra transmission fluid (under hood or in trunk)
Extra Antifreeze (stored under hood or in trunk)
Extra motor oil (stored under hood or in trunk)
Jumper cables (stored under hood or in trunk)
Spare fan belt (stored under hood or in trunk)
Tarp or plastic drop sheet (stored in trunk)
Tire repair kit (stored in glove box or trunk)
Disposable plastic gloves (stored in trunk)
Small mechanics toolbox (stored in trunk)
Road flares (stored in trunk)

Travel Bag (with wheels) or Backpack

Knife (fixed blade) & Flashlight (extra batteries)
Blanket (in plastic bag) – one for each person
Jacket/Raincoat – Gloves – Sunglasses – Hat
Cash (small denominations & coins)
Walking clothes & shoes & socks
Snacks & 1 bottle of water
First-aid kit + medications
Personal toiletries + soap
Handkerchief

Emergency-type Items

- *Fire starter kit + small amount of combustible fuel
- *Metal bowl & metal spoon one for each person
- *Freeze-dried &/or dehydrated food + snack food
- *Something to boil water in (pot, pan or #10 can)
- *Water filter (hand pump or gravity feed type)
- *Toilet paper (in plastic bag) & Clorox wipes
- *Sharpie & note pad (stored in Ziploc bag)
- *Trash bags (large size, 2 or more)
- *Candle(s) emergency type
- *FR radio (extra batteries)
- *Zip ties various sizes
- *Shovel (small foldable)
- *Twine or string 50'
- *Small axe or hatchet
- *Rope 50-100'
- *Duct tape
- *Wire 10'
- *store these items in bucket

Bucket w/lid & handle (5-gallon size)

Bottled water (1 case for every 2-3 persons)
