Unexpected Issues

Last 2 Questions:

- Ranking reversed:
 - 1st half of survey, 1 = LEAST important
 - 2nd half, 1 = MOST important
- 34% misinterpreted instructions to rank only 10 of the attributes, not all of them
- 66% ranked these 38 questions correctly, and those were the ones used

Water:

- Only 2 questions on survey, more needed
- Evident in the Comments how important the issue is



AREA = HERITAGE DISCOVERY (HD)

2. Need more weed control. Need more streetlights. Streets are too dark and hard to see. Need more food businesses. Open spaces. Affordable housing for families. Locally owned restaurant. No overnight rentals. Tight knit family-oriented city.

4. Attention to road systems should be given before housing developments are allowed. Coming from Oceanside, CA, the homeless problem was bad and getting worse. This entire area needs to stop this problem before it gets out of hand because it will get worse.

7. Concerned growth outgrows water availability.


I finally decided to complete this survey after much thought. I'm not sure this isn't a waste of my time. Will this information and feedback really have an impact?


3. How would you rate public safety in Ivins (Police/Fire/EMS)?










13. Bike Lanes








15. Public Art in Outdoor Public Spaces








23. Install Traffic Signals at Busy Intersections Rather Than Roundabouts
